

## Final Draft Obituary

Carol Schliecher passed away on September 6, 2018 after a 20 month struggle with T-cell Lymphoma. She was born Carol Jane Wallace in April 1958 in Ventura CA to Stanley and Mary Jane Wallace. She attended Elmhurst elementary school, Balboa Junior High, and graduated from Buena High School in the class of 1976 where she had a straight A average. As a preschooler she began taking dance lessons at Billy Clower Dance Studio, advancing to the highest level in high school and continuing her dance training while she attended college. She graduated from Ventura College in 1978 and attended UCSB. During college she taught dance lessons for the Ventura City Recreation Dept. Carol worked for Oxnard Union High School district for nearly 30 years, mainly as Administrative Secretary at Oxnard High School. She was a Christian woman who attended Sacred Heart Church in Ventura for many years. She loved plants, baking, and animals, and had almost every type of pet over the last 40 years. She was a chocoholic and ate many pounds of Sees candy over her lifetime. She was born a sports fan and was a lifelong fan of the LA Lakers and the LA Dodgers, as well as supporting her children and grandchildren in their many sports activities. She was known for her kindness and sweet nature. In addition to her mother, Mary Jane Wallace, husband, Terry Schliecher, daughter Sara and son Jason along with her 4 grandchildren, Austin, Makynlee, Talan, and Dylenn, she is survived by her sisters Jean Smith, Lynn Ferrin, and Beth Terry, their spouses, and many nieces and nephews. She loved her home town of Ventura and was a third-generation resident of Ventura County.
