

### The Ascension of the Lord

“Why are you standing there looking at the sky?” We can only imagine the apostles’ astonishment, not only at Jesus’ ascension, but at the message from the men in white garments who appeared at that very moment. Jesus had been crucified and died, rose from the dead and spent time with them, teaching them to understand how he had fulfilled all that had been written about the Messiah, and suddenly, he was taken up to heaven. Surely they would have wondered what was happening and what the meaning of Jesus’ ascension was. We wonder with them. What does Jesus’ ascension call us to be or do? We rely on the testimony of those who were with Jesus to grasp the mystery of his life, death, resurrection, and ascension. Their witness calls us to believe in Jesus, grow in relationship with him, and live as his disciples in the world.

### La Ascensión del Señor

“¿Por qué están ahí mirando hacia el cielo?” solo podemos imaginar el asombro de los apóstoles, no sólo por la ascensión de Jesús, sino por el mensaje que los hombres vestidos de blanco se aparecieron en ese mismo momento. Jesús fue crucificado y murió, resucitó de entre los muertos y había pasado un tiempo con ellos, enseñándoles a entender cómo había cumplido todo lo que se había escrito sobre el Mesías, y de repente, era llevado al cielo. Seguramente se habían preguntado qué estaba pasando y cuál era el significado de la ascensión de Jesús. Junto con ellos también nos sorprendemos. ¿Para nosotros, qué significa y a qué nos llama a ser o hacer la Ascensión de Jesús? Nos basamos en el testimonio de aquellos que estuvieron con Jesús para comprender el misterio de su vida, muerte, resurrección y ascensión. Su testimonio nos llama a crecer en Jesús, a crecer en la relación con él y a vivir como sus discípulos en el mundo.

### YOU HAVE SEEN AND HEARD, NOW GO DO

It isn't enough to say we believe in Jesus. We are called to live as members of Christ's body and share the joy of faith with others. We do this by discerning and fulfilling our vocation, the ways in which God calls each of us to live. Often when we think of vocation, the first thing that comes to mind is the priesthood. But each of us experience vocational calls, to our state in life and to the ways in which we live, work, and serve. Each of us has been given different gifts and are called according to our gifts. We are equipped with talents and skills through which we may contribute to bringing the mercy, compassion, truth, goodness, and beauty of God's love to the world. What are your particular gifts and talents? How may you be called to use them to bring Christ's love to others, leading them to see and hear the Good News of Jesus Christ?

The conclusion of the Novena to Saint Rita is her Feast Day of May 22nd.

Blessed red roses will be distributed. The custom of blessing and distributing roses commemorates the blooming of a rose in the garden of the saint's home in the cold of winter." Rita, on her death bed, had requested a relative to bring her a rose from her winter garden, which she hastened to bring to the saint. It also commemorates the sweet odor which emanates from the body of the saint at times when she bestows her favors upon her followers. Vatican officials, in their investigation of her life, were so impressed with this event that they accepted it as one of the miracles required for her canonization.




**THE SIGNIFICANCE OF THE ASCENSION**

The theological unity, or perhaps even the temporal experience of the early community, made it seem that Jesus' resurrection and his ascension were inseparable aspects of a single mystery. Only in the later writings of Luke and John has further theological reflection helped the Christian community to distinguish different dimensions of the mystery. Liturgical tradition has followed the forty-day chronology formulated by Luke. We would miss the point, however, if we were to demand a precise historical chronology of events such as the Resurrection-Ascension that are primarily spiritual in nature and that clearly surpass the bounds of time and space as we know them.

What is important for us to grasp is the significance of the Ascension. For Luke, it is the decisive turning point that marks the end of Jesus' earthly ministry and the beginning of the disciples' Spirit-led ministry and thus the ministry of the whole church down to our own day.

**EL SIGNIFICADO DE LA ASCENSIÓN**

La unión teológica, o tal vez la experiencia temporal de la primera comunidad cristiana, hizo parecer que la Resurrección y Ascensión de Jesús eran aspectos inseparables de un único misterio. Solo en los últimos escritos de Lucas y Juan la reflexión teológica que iba madurando ayudó a la comunidad cristiana distinguir las diferentes dimensiones del misterio. La tradición litúrgica ha seguido la cronología de cuarenta días formulada por Lucas. No comprenderíamos lo esencial, sin embargo, si exigiéramos una cronología precisa de acontecimientos históricos como la Resurrección y la Ascensión que son principalmente de naturaleza espiritual y que superan claramente los límites del tiempo y el espacio tal como los conocemos.

Lo que es importante es que comprendamos el significado de la Ascensión. Para Lucas, es el momento decisivo que marca el final del ministerio terrenal de Jesús y el comienzo del ministerio guiado por el Espíritu de los discípulos, y por lo tanto el ministerio de toda la Iglesia hasta nuestros días.

They can tell you if you need to head to the emergency room or if you can take steps at home.
