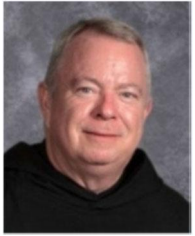

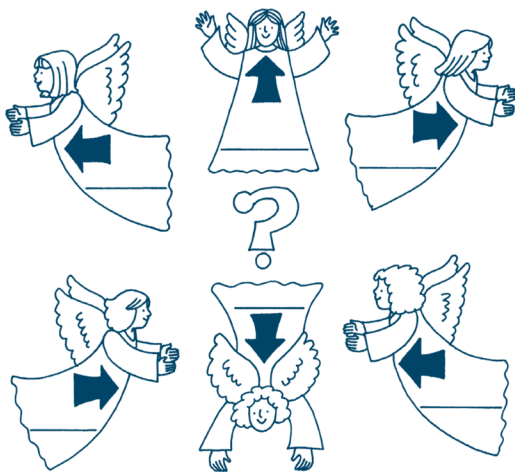

THE REWARD

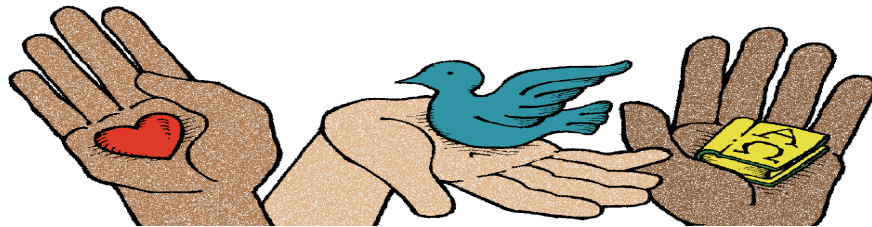
