Letter from Fr Kirk

Our celebrations of Christmas and New Years are behind us and we find ourselves looking ahead to another year. At the same time, we're continuing to experience profound disruptions to our daily lives caused by the ongoing pandemic. As I write this message in time for the bulletin deadline (December 23), updated protocols from Archbishop Gomez dictate that parishes in Ventura and Santa Barbara Counties continue to be allowed to offer public worship either outdoors or via livestream only. We will of course continue to monitor protocols and make adjustments to how we gather as indicated.

Looking ahead, one question that has been asked frequently is: "What do we do if it rains?" After considerable discernment and conversations with stakeholders and among ourselves, Fr. Fernando and I have decided that in the event of rain being present before any of our weekday or Sunday celebrations of Mass, we will offer that Mass from inside the church via livestream only. Put another way, if you find it's raining when you leave the house to come to church, most likely an "in person" Mass will not be available to you that day and you are invited to join us via livestream.

Continuing news about the increasing availability of vaccines lifts my spirits and gives me hope that one day soon we will be able to return to celebrating as we used to.

Nuestras celebraciones de Navidad y Año Nuevo ya están detrás de nosotros y nos encontramos mirando hacia otro año. Al mismo tiempo, seguimos experimentando profundas perturbaciones en nuestra vida diaria causadas por la pandemia. Mientras escribo este mensaje a tiempo para la fecha límite del boletín (23 de diciembre), los protocolos actualizados del arzobispo Gómez dictan que las parroquias de los condados de Ventura y Santa Bárbara sigan ofreciendo culto público al aire libre o solo a través de la transmisión en directo. Por supuesto, seguiremos supervisando los protocolos y haciendo ajustes en la forma en que nos reunimos como se indica. De cara al futuro, una pregunta que se ha hecho con frecuencia es: "¿Qué hacemos si llueve?" Después de un considerable discernimiento y conversaciones con las partes interesadas y entre nosotros, el P. Fernando y yo hemos decidido que en caso de lluvia esté presente antes de cualquiera de nuestras celebraciones de la Misa de lunes a sábado, o dominical, ofreceremos esa misa desde el interior de la iglesia sólo a través de livestream. Dicho de otra manera, si encuentras que está lloviendo cuando sales de la casa para venir a la iglesia, lo más probable es que una misa "en persona" no estará disponible para ti ese día y te invitamos a unírte a nosotros a través de la transmisión en vivo.

Las continuas noticias sobre la creciente disponibilidad de vacunas me levantan el ánimo y me dan la esperanza de que un día pronto podremos volver a celebrar como solíamos hacerlo.

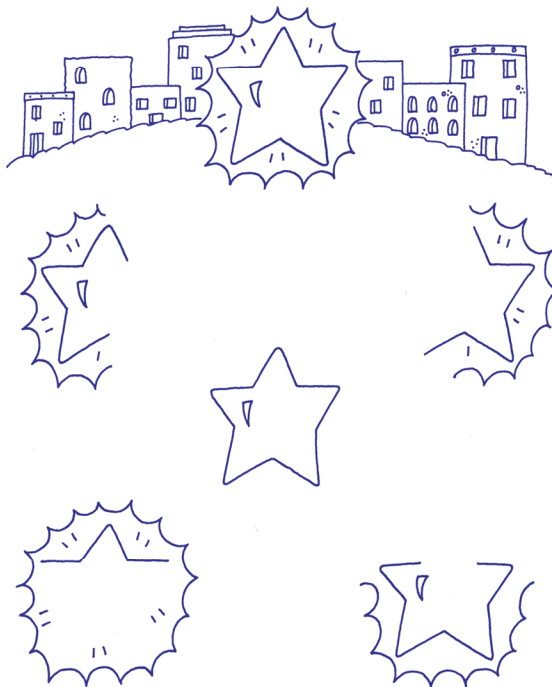

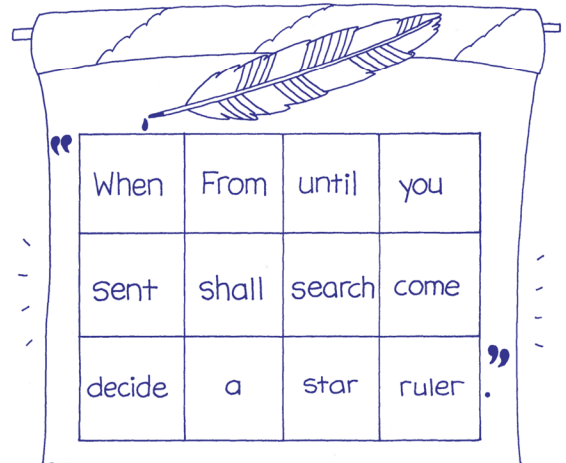

FEAST OF FAITH

The Liturgy of Emmanuel

The assembly has gathered from near and far, on foot, by bus, by car, by subway, singly and by twos and threes: single people, couples, families. Now that movement is ritualized and made visible in the liturgy's entrance procession.

We are not alone on this journey; Christ is with us. The procession is led by the cross, with the image of Christ upon it. Candles, signs of a living presence, are carried around the cross. Candles also accompany the Book of the Gospels, another sign of Emmanuel, God-with-us. The priest presider is likewise a sign of Christ's presence in our assembly; he will act in persona Christi, in the person of Christ, who presides at every Eucharist.

As the procession begins, we stand and sing together in our first act as a community. The joining of our voices begins to turn many into one. The songs we sing range from ancient chants to contemporary hymns, but they have the same purpose, to foster our unity and turn our thoughts to the mysteries we gather to celebrate. We may feel that we can't sing well, but "Christ always invites us to enter into song, to rise above our own preoccupations, and to give our entire selves to the hymn of his Paschal Sacrifice" (USCCB, Sing to the Lord, 14).

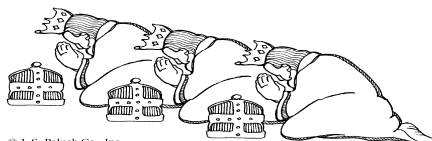
FIESTA DE LA FE

La liturgia de Emmanuel

La asamblea se ha reunido desde cerca y lejos, a pie, en autobús, en coche, en metro, solo y por dos y tres: personas solteras, parejas, familias. Ahora ese movimiento se ritualiza y se hace visible en la procesión de entrada de la liturgia.

No estamos solos en este viaje; Cristo está con nosotros. La procesión es guiada por la cruz, con la imagen de Cristo sobre ella. Las velas, signos de una presencia viva, se llevan alrededor de la cruz. Las velas también acompañan el Libro de los Evangelios, otro signo de Emmanuel, Dios con nosotros. El sacerdote presidente es también un signo de la presencia de Cristo en nuestra asamblea; actuará en persona Christi, en la persona de Cristo, que preside cada Eucaristía.

A medida que comienza la procesión, nos ponemos de pie y nos aliamos juntos en nuestro primer acto como comunidad. La unión de nuestras voces comienza a convertir a muchos en uno. Las canciones que cantamos van desde cantos antiguos hasta himnos contemporáneos, pero tienen el mismo propósito, fomentar nuestra unidad y volver nuestros pensamientos a los misterios que reunimos para celebrar. Podemos sentir que no podemos cantar bien, pero "Cristo siempre nos invita a entrar en el canto, a elevarnos por encima de nuestras propias preocupaciones y a dar todo nuestro yo al himno de su sacrificio pascual" (USCCB, Sing to the Lord, 14).

The Epiphany of the Lord

In Matthew's Gospel today we see two extremely different perspectives, two different reasons for searching for Jesus. In some ways, this resembles the polarization of our nation in today's time. What one group sees as good for the nation, those with opposing views think will wreck the country. The Magi were astrologers who saw a vision in the sky and were trying to find a way to follow it and discover the new king of the Jews. Herod heard about this king, and his reaction was dark and negative. He saw the birth of such a king as a threat to his power as the Roman leader of the country and wanted the Magi to pass on to him what they knew about this Christ child. Similarly, on a more personal level, we can either feel threatened or excited by changes that may come, depending on our perspective.

**GIVING HOMAGE**

In our minds, it is easy to mix up bits and pieces from Luke's account of the shepherds coming to see Jesus in the stable and the story of the magi. Clearly, it has taken the magi time to get here, and the reading speaks of them coming to the house where the star led them. Nevertheless, they "prostrated themselves and did him homage. Then they opened their treasures . . ."

How do we do this? Do we continue looking for Jesus, even if it takes a while and he is not where we expect to see him? Are we paying attention to the signs showing us the way? What gifts do we have with which to pay him homage? After seeing him, the Magi were warned in a dream not to go back the way they came. But if we have seen the Christ child, how can we go back to where we were? We must continue to respond to God's call to move forward and grow in our lives. We must seek the right and just path and turn away from the "Herods" and inherent evils in our life.

En el Evangelio de hoy de Mateo vemos dos perspectivas extremadamente diferentes, dos razones diferentes para buscar a Jesús. En cierto modo, esto se parece a la polarización de nuestra nación en el tiempo actual. Lo que un grupo ve como bueno para la nación, quienes tienen puntos de vista opuestos piensan que eso arruinará el país. Los Reyes Magos eran astrólogos que vieron una visión en el cielo y trataban de encontrar una forma de seguirlo y descubrir al nuevo rey de los judíos. Herodes escuchó acerca de este rey y su reacción fue oscura y negativa. Él vio el nacimiento de tal rey como una amenaza a su poder como líder romano del país y pidió a los Reyes Mayos le dijeran lo que sabían sobre ese niño mesías. De igual manera, en un nivel más personal, ya sea que nos podamos sentir amenazados o emocionados por los cambios que puedan venir, dependiendo de nuestra perspectiva.

DANDO HOMENAJE

En nuestras mentes, es fácil mezclar pedazos y piezas del relato de Lucas que cuenta acerca de los pastores que vinieron a ver a Jesús en el establo y la historia de los magos. Claramente, a los magos les tomó tiempo llegar hasta ahí y la lectura habla de ellos yendo a la casa donde la estrella los guiaba. Sin embargo, "se postraron y le rindieron homenaje. Luego abrieron sus tesoros . . ."

¿Cómo lo hacemos? ¿Seguimos buscando a Jesús, aunque tarde un poco y no esté donde esperamos verlo? ¿Estamos atentos a las señales que nos indican el camino? ¿Qué regalos tenemos para rendirle homenaje? Después de verlo, en un sueño los magos fueron advertidos de no regresar por donde habían ido. Pero si ya vimos al niño Jesús, ¿cómo podemos regresar por donde estábamos? Debemos seguir respondiendo al llamado de Dios para avanzar y crecer en nuestras vidas. Debemos buscar el camino justo y correcto y alejarnos de "Herodes" y de los males propios de nuestra vida.
