The table above indicates the financial status in the recent two months ending on September 30, 2022. The last column provides the Fiscal Year 22/23 income and expenses to date. With staff Holiday and vacation schedules the month of October full reconciliation has not yet been completed. The unrestricted income is approximately \$12,000 lower for the first 3 months of the current fiscal year as compared to the same timeframe for the last fiscal year. The Parish requested and received a \$20,000 transfer from its Investment Pool (with the Los Angeles Archdiocese) in September to cover operating expenses. Without this transfer the net listed above for September would have also been negative. The bottom line is that the Parish monthly income does not meet monthly operational expenses. As we have all experienced, in these times of high inflation, utilities, food, etc. all cost significantly more than they did last year. The Parish administration has done a very good job in reducing costs where ever feasible and advisable but further reductions will be very challenging. Therefore, the Parish administration will be focusing more on means to raise income to offset these expense increases.

The parish Festival netted just over \$25,000 in income thanks to the hard work of the Festival planning committee and the multitude of volunteers and donations. The Thanksgiving Community Dinner fed over 100 attendees and volunteers and raised over \$1200 that will go to the St. Vincent de Paul Society to provide food and assistance to those in need.

The Together in Mission campaign is still active. The goal for our Parish is just over \$37,000. As of November 21, 2022 the Parish pledges total just over \$21,000 or approximately 57% of the goal. If you have not done so already and were planning on contributing to the campaign, please do so as soon as feasible. Should you have misplaced your contribution envelope please contact the Parish office.

Coming soon the Parish will begin a partnership fundraising project with the Archdiocese of Los Angeles known as the "Call to Renew." The funding raised will be utilized to repair and upgrade the Parish facilities. One of the identified projects includes the complete resurfacing and restriping of the parish parking lot. Look for information in the bulletin and pulpit announcements about this exciting opportunity.



## Did you know?

### California act protects children online

The California Age-Appropriate Design Code Act, which was signed into law in September, requires companies to assess potential harm in how they use data from children (defined as any user under 18) in new services or features, and to enact plans to reduce risk. Companies are also banned from using minors' information in "materially detrimental" ways, such as routing searches for weight loss to photos of supermodels, and from collecting, sharing, or selling a minor's personal information by default. ## La ley de California protege a los niños conectados en línea

La Ley del Código de Diseño Apropriado para la Edad de California, que se convirtió en ley en septiembre, requiere que las empresas evalúen el daño potencial en la forma en que utilizan los datos de los niños (definidos como cualquier usuario menor de 18 años) en nuevos servicios o funciones, y promulgar planes para reducir el riesgo. Las empresas también tienen prohibido usar la información de menores de manera "materialmente prejudicial", como enrutar búsquedas de pérdida de peso a fotos de supermodelos, y recopilar, compartir o vender la información personal de un menor de forma prede terminada. Have you ever known a moment when, just for a brief instant, you felt that all was right with the world? It is just such a moment, stretched into eternity, that the writer of Isaiah describes in today's first reading: the perfection of everything, centered in God's spirit, where knowledge, justice, and awe in God's presence reign. Even animals with a natural animosity toward one another coexist peacefully. John the Baptist understood that such harmonious relationships do not simply happen. They are the fruit of living in right relationship with God and others.
