Ojai Valley Family Shelter

The OVFS sponsors a Winter Overnight Shelter program from December thru March for those in need. Dinners and Bag Lunches are provided by the various Churches here in the Ojai Valley. STA has the responsibility of providing Dinner every Tuesday. A group of dedicated culinary volunteers including Villanova Prep commit to one Tuesday per month preparing 8-12 dinners and 6-10 bag lunches. One of our regular meal prep groups opted out of the rotation this year, so we are asking for a new group to volunteer for next year. The commitment would be for one Tuesday per month for four months: December - March.


