Fr. Kirks Message
June 21, 2020

The year 2020 is likely to be a memorable one for many reasons. To be sure the Covid 19 virus has given us all new focus on things that we have previously taken for granted.

One example is the 'virtual' graduation ceremony for my nephew, who graduated from high school last week. He and all his classmates, their parents and families, and the faculty of the school gathered online for a two-hour celebration. Amazing! Another example has been the civil unrest and call to dialogue around racial injustice in our nation. To be sure we have seen similar unrest in the past, yet somehow the call to dialogue seems more urgent today, and many appear to be taking the invitation to listen seriously.

Our way of being 'church' has been challenged, forcing us to learn how to livestream our masses, and then to gather with social distancing and safety protocols in place. All of these things invite us to a mindfulness that might not otherwise be demanded. I hope and pray that our reflections on the times we are living in yield the fruit of an even stronger and more confident faith in God.

This weekend we celebrate the secular holiday of Father's Day. While the celebrations may look different this year, I pray the spirit remains strong. May God bless all fathers today, those who are the heads of traditional families to be sure, but also all the men out there who inhabit the role of 'father' in nontraditional ways...who extend the love of a father to corners of our communities that otherwise might not enjoy a fathers love. MINISTRIES IN NEED OF YOU

When we are able to come together, each of our ministries are in need of new people who can bring their time and talent; ideas and energy. Below is an example of three different types of Ministries. Perhaps you will see a place for you. Every person who is now or has been involved in a Ministry will tell you they get more out of participating than they have given.

LAITY

This is a general term that describes all of us who are not clergy. Laity in Greek is laos, "The people". Vatican II recaptured the original meaning of the word, reminding us that laity is all the people of God who are called through baptism to transform the world.

APOSTOLATE

This word comes from apostle, as in one who is sent by Jesus to proclaim the Gospel....by word and deed. Lay Apostolate is the work most of the laity do everyday to transform the world and spread the love of Jesus. This is done through work as mothers, fathers, teachers, farmers, doctors, clerks, students, our everyday life.

LAY MINISTRY

This is used as a general term referring to lay activity in the Church. Vatican II renewed these ministerial roles. These ministries are, volunteer positions, extraordinary ministers, lectors, catechist, acolyte, and cantor to name a few. It also includes those who have a more professional role in the church like youth minister, director of Religious Education and RCIA coordinator.

MINISTERIO LAICO




